General Guidelines

- Please make cheques payable to CMRA
- For families in need of financial assistance, call Kidsport Tri-Cities (604-341-0241).
- A uniform deposit cheque of \$75, dated May 1st, 2011, is required at time of registration.
- New players must include a copy of their birth certificate with their registration form. We must have this on file before a player can be assigned a team and allowed on the ice.
- The LMRL (Lower Mainland Ringette League) is mandating each Association to validate member residence for the 2010/2011 season. Please provide a copy of proof of your residence with your registration form. Acceptable proof of residence documents are:
 - Utility bill (hydro, water, gas, telephone, cable TV, public utilities commission)
 - Drivers license
 - Cancelled personalize cheque
 - Mortgage, lease, or rental agreement
 - Insurance policy
 - Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
 - Any document from the City or Government of Canada that has your name and address
- A \$50 discount is offered to families with multiple players registered.
- If applicable, please include a copy of your Kidsport application.
- Official receipts will be distributed in January 2011.
- Goalie rebates are available. Contact us for more information.

Payment Option for Early Registrations only

We will accept post dated cheques only for registrations received by May 31st. The first payment of 50% of the total registration fee (subject to a minimum payment of \$125) must be dated for May 31st. The balance due must be post dated for August 31st. **CMRA requires that both post dated cheques be submitted with the registration form.** Please note that your cheques must be cashable on the date issued (NSF cheques will be subject to an additional fee).

Refunds

- Refunds requested prior to September 15th: total, less \$ 35
- Refunds requested from September 16th-30th: total, less \$ 70
- After October 1st, refunds may be considered on a pro rated basis when requests are submitted in writing

The Team Selection Process

Players will be evaluated over a minimum of two practice sessions for skating, passing, shooting and game sense. The evaluators will be 3-5 volunteers with no children playing at the level they are assessing. Injured or absent players will be assigned to a team after two assessments. Team numbers will be balanced as evenly as possible unless assessed skill level dictates otherwise. **All teams will be formed based on Lower Mainland Ringette League/British Columbia Ringette Association rules.**

Practices, Games and Family Responsibilities

There is generally one week night practice per week and one or two games each weekend. Most games are played in the Lower Mainland area but some may be on Vancouver Island. Your child will have to travel to these places throughout the season. A team may also choose to participate in a tournament that will involve three to five games over a few days, and may involve out of town travel.

It is the responsibility of all parents and/or guardians to participate fully in team and association support duties. Duties may include score keeping, time keeping, team management, coaching, bench assistance, tournament help, etc. Families that do not participate in duties may be subject to a monetary fee payable to the association. The amount of this fee and the number of support hours for the tournament will be determined by the Executive and Tournament Committee each season.

An optional \$50 fundraising fee may be included with your registration if you choose not to participate in Association fundraising efforts. This fee does not apply to team or other association support duties (such as those listed above). Fundraising activities will be determined by the Executive and Fundraising Coordinator each season. Each family will be expected to participate in all fundraising efforts if they do not pay the \$50 fee.

All association equipment is to be returned at the end of the season in good condition, or reimbursements paid to the association for replacement costs.
